About this initiative

VicScreen is offering a limited number of All Access conference passes to First Peoples who are based in Victoria to attend the Australian International Documentary Conference (AIDC).

AIDC is Australia's premier event for documentary, factual and unscripted screen content. The 2024 program will feature a four-day marketplace, forum, and screening program. AIDC attracts a diverse mix of broadcasters, storytellers, entrepreneurs, and documentary fans from Australia, the Asia-Pacific and beyond.

Eligibility

This initiative is open to First Peoples of Australia producers, writers and/or directors who are living in <u>Victoria</u> and have clear objectives for how attending the conference will advance their career and/or projects.

- How attending will benefit the applicant's career and/or projects
- · Strength of the candidate's stated objectives for attending AIDC
- VicScreen's overall objectives of diversity and inclusiveness.

Important dates

- Deadline for applications is 11pm on 20 December 2023
- Applicants notified of outcome by 12 January 2024





AIDC will take place 3 - 6 March 2024

Assessment process and timeline

Funding is competitive. When assessing applications, VicScreen will consider:

- · How attending the conference will benefit the applicant's career and/or projects
- The strength of the candidate's stated objectives for attending AIDC
- VicScreen's overall objectives of diversity and inclusiveness.

Applicants will be advised of the application outcome within four weeks of the deadline.

Successful applicants

- Will be contacted by email confirming VicScreen's support and any relevant terms and conditions
- Will receive a four-day All Access Pass to the AIDC conference. This pass provides access to all AIDC sessions, professional development activities and networking opportunities.
