

Kidscreen Summit 2024 - International Market Travel Guidelines

Fssentials

About this initiative

VicScreen is offering financial assistance to eligible Victorian producers who are planning to attend the Kidscreen Summit in February 2024. VicScreen is supporting experienced producers who are seeking international broadcast/SVOD financing partners, sales agents, or potential co-production partners for their television projects.

Who is eligible?

- You must be a <u>Victorian company</u> or an individual <u>Victorian resident</u>.
- Have one or more current projects to pitch at Kidscreen Summit 2024 that are at an appropriate level of development and are suitable to pitch to international broadcast/SVOD financing partners, sales agents, or potential co-production partners
- Have one of the following:
 - Credits as a producer on at least three hours of qualifying drama this can include:
 - » Drama or narrative comedy telemovies, series and serials that have been broadcast on television or commissioned or acquired by a major online content provider
 - » Feature films that have been theatrically released or commissioned or acquired by a major online content provider
 - Confirmed market interest on a project.

What can you receive funding for?

- Grants of up to AUD\$5,000 per applicant are available for travel from Victoria to San Diego to attend Kidscreen Summit 2024
- Grants can be spent on airfares, ground transport, accommodation, market registration, travel insurance
- Successful applicants must cover the cost of travel up front and will be reimbursed by VicScreen
 on the provision of relevant receipts and an acquittal report at the conclusion of travel up to the
 Grant amount
- VicScreen will only fund one grant per company. Funds may be used to support the travel expenses of Victorian company representative/s, provided they have the requisite experience to represent the project and have been approved by VicScreen.





• A limited number of applicants will be funded.

The Details

Important dates

- Deadline for applications is 11 pm on 5 December 2023
- Applicants notified of outcome by 20 December 2023
- Kidscreen Summit will take place 4 7 February 2024

What happens after you apply?

Funding is competitive. When assessing applications VicScreen will consider:

- The applicant's objectives for travel to Kidscreen Summit 2024
- The relevance of the applicant's project/s for Kidscreen Summit 2024
- · The applicant's recent track record in securing market commitments to projects in development
- Previous support received from VicScreen or any other agency in recent years
- How the project's content, and the cast and key creatives involved, address diversity, inclusivity
 and gender equity.

What happens if you get funding?

- Successful applicants will be contacted by email confirming VicScreen's support and any relevant terms and conditions
- The applicant will need to book their own flights, insurance and accommodation
- The applicant will receive payment **after** completion of travel and provision of relevant receipts and an acquittal report. Please note that booking confirmations and reservation documents will not be accepted in place of receipts.

What happens if you don't get funding?

- If your application is unsuccessful, we will contact you via email to let you know.
