The Victorian Screen Rebate (VSR) is a competitive and simple grant to bring your production to Victoria. An incentive to make our state your stage.

Is my project eligible?

To qualify, spend a minimum of AU\$3.5 million on physical production in Victoria.

Your project must be a film or series that is footloose, fully financed and has genuine marketplace interest for commercial release or distribution at the time of application.

How much can I apply for?

Film in Victoria, and you can apply for a grant of up to 10% of your project's Qualifying Victorian Expenditure (QVE) that is paid upon project completion.

VSR can be combined with any of the Federal Offsets and domestic projects may be eligible for an additional grant if filming in regional Victoria.
